Retro Groove Cutting charts

The fabric requirements are fairly precise for this pattern. If you prefer to have extra fabric on hand, consider gathering an extra fat quarter to 1/4 yd extra of Fabrics A-H, K-N when cutting the template pieces.

I have provided cutting charts to minimize having to purchase excess fabrics.

The charts showing Templates 1, 2, and 3 being cut are all shown with the fabric folded in half, selvage to selvage (as it comes folded on the bolt). The charts showing standard straight cutting are shown with the fabric opened to the full width.




Retro Groove Cutting chart for Templates 1 & 2 (Fabrics A-H, K-N)

When using templates, you can speed up the cutting by folding the fabric in half so it's 21" wide instead of opening it to the full 42" width. I leave mine folded, as it comes on the bolt, and cut two pieces of fabric with the template at a time.

If your fabric is directional, be mindful




42" wide fabric, folded in half (as it comes off the bolt), so approx. 21" wide as pictured

If your fabric is directional, be mindful of the placement of the template on the fabric prior to cutting.




Retro Groove Cutting chart for borders (Fabric J)

Cutting layout for fabric J (continued) Border only


