

Retro Groove Cutting charts

The fabric requirements are fairly precise for this pattern. If you prefer to have extra fabric on hand, consider gathering an extra fat quarter to 1/4 yd extra of Fabrics A-H, K-N when cutting the template pieces.

I have provided cutting charts to minimize having to purchase excess fabrics.

The charts showing Templates 1, 2, and 3 being cut are all shown with the fabric folded in half, selvage to selvage (as it comes folded on the bolt). The charts showing standard straight cutting are shown with the fabric opened to the full width.

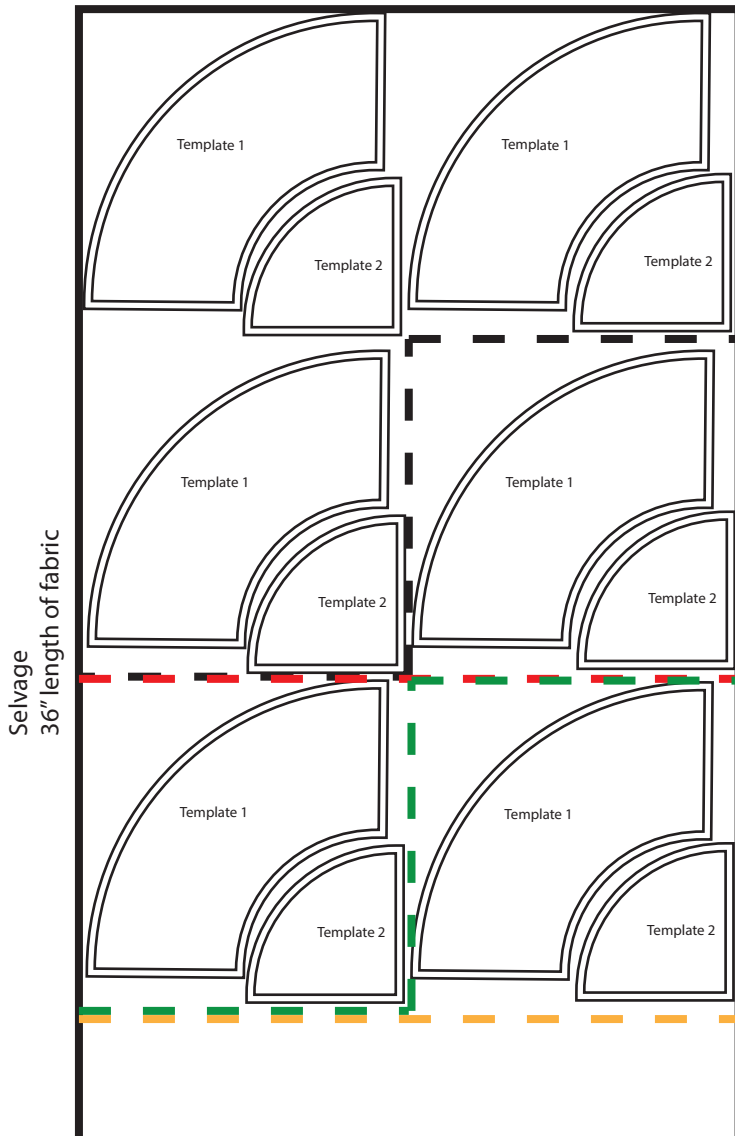

Cutting chart for Templates 1 & 2 (Fabrics A-H, K-N)

When using templates, you can speed up the cutting by folding the fabric in half so it's 21" wide instead of opening it to the full 42" width. I leave mine folded, as it comes on the bolt, and cut two pieces of fabric with the template at a time.

Cutting layout for each of fabrics A-N
 3/4 yd for each of these fabrics for baby, throw, twin.
 1 yd needed for queen and king.

If your fabric is directional, be mindful of the placement of the template on the fabric prior to cutting. More fabric may be needed for fussy cutting.



Fabric is folded in half here. Speed up the cutting by doubling the fabric to cut 2 templates at once.

Baby, Throw, Twin: 3/4 yds
 Black dashed line on chart
 Baby-Cut 6 each of Templates 1 & 2 from Fabrics A-F
 Throw-Cut 6 of each Templates 1 & 2 from Fabrics A-H
 Red Dashed line on chart
 Twin-Cut 8 of each Templates 1 & 2 from Fabrics A-H, K, L

The fabric requirements are fairly precise for this pattern. If you prefer to have extra or leftover fabric, consider gathering an extra fat quarter to 1/4 yd. of fabrics A-H, K-N.

Queen, King: 1 yd
 Green dashed line on chart
 Queen-Cut 10 each of Templates 1 & 2 from Fabrics A-H, K-N
 Orange Dashed line on chart
 King-Cut 12 of each Templates 1 & 2 from Fabrics A-H, K-N

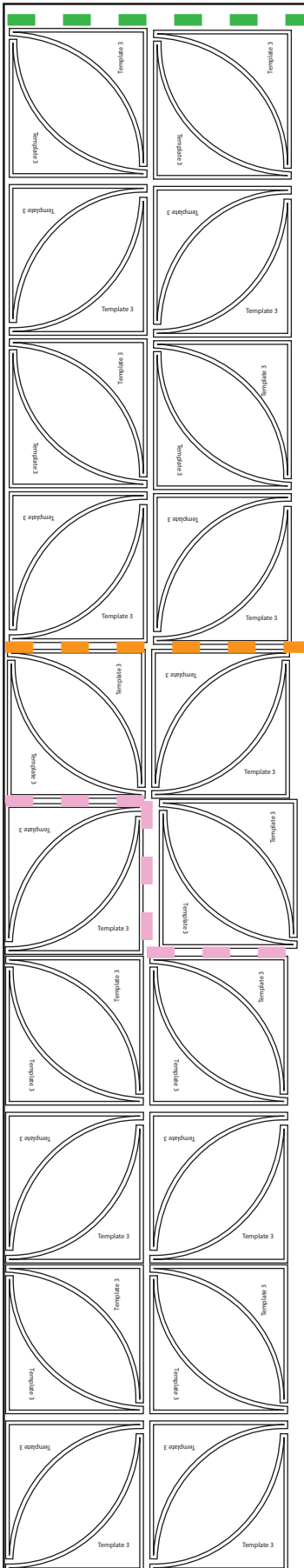

Cutting chart for Template 3 (Fabric J)

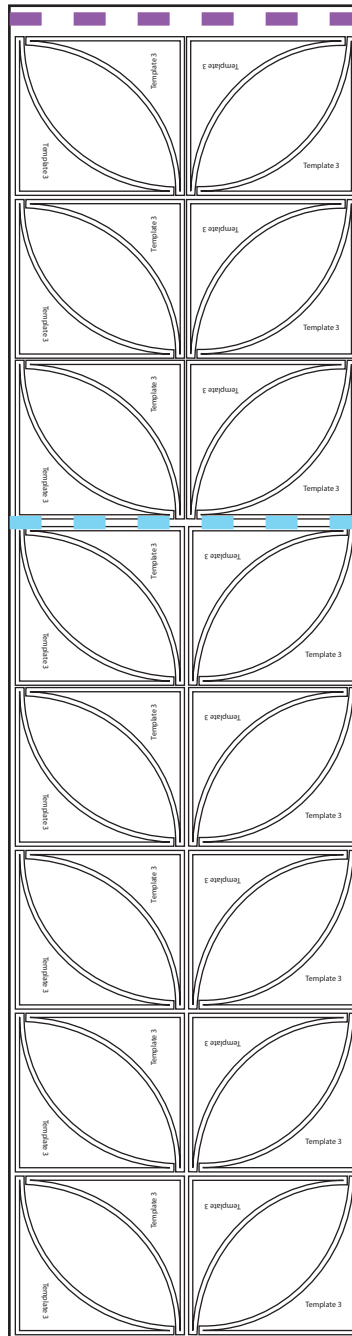
When using templates, you can speed up the cutting by folding the fabric in half so it's 21" wide instead of opening it to the full 42" width. I leave mine folded, as it comes on the bolt, and cut two pieces of fabric with the template at a time.

Selvage
3 yd. length of fabric



42" wide fabric, folded in half (as it comes off the bolt), so approx. 21" wide as pictured

Selvage
80" length of fabric



42" wide fabric, folded in half (as it comes off the bolt), so approx. 21" wide as pictured

Cutting layout for fabric J
 Baby-cut only whats below the pink dashed line
 Throw-cut the amount below the pink and orange dashed lines
 Twin-cut the amount below the pink, orange, green dashed lines
 Queen-Cut the amount below the pink, orange, green, blue dashed lines
 King-Cut all pieces

-  Pink dashed line - BABY
-  Orange dashed line - THROW
-  Green dashed line - TWIN
-  Blue dashed line - QUEEN
-  Purple dashed line - KING

If your fabric is directional, be mindful of the placement of the template on the fabric prior to cutting.

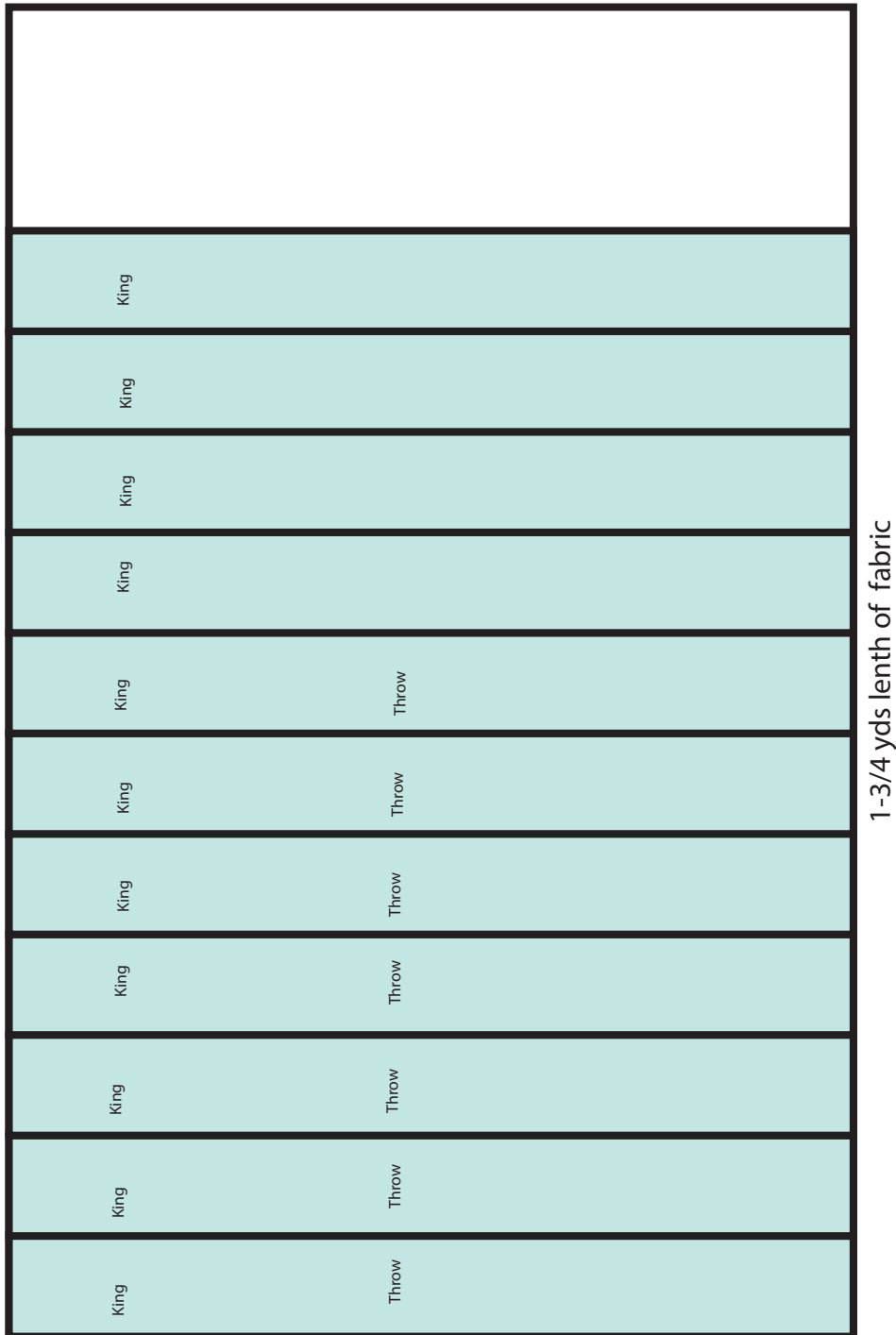
Cutting chart for borders (Fabric J)

This diagram shows the fabric opened to the full 42" width, not folded in half as it was in the template cutting diagrams.

Cutting layout for fabric J (continued) Border only

Need 1-1-8 yds for THROW . Cut (7) 5" x WOF strips then piece together border pieces THROW

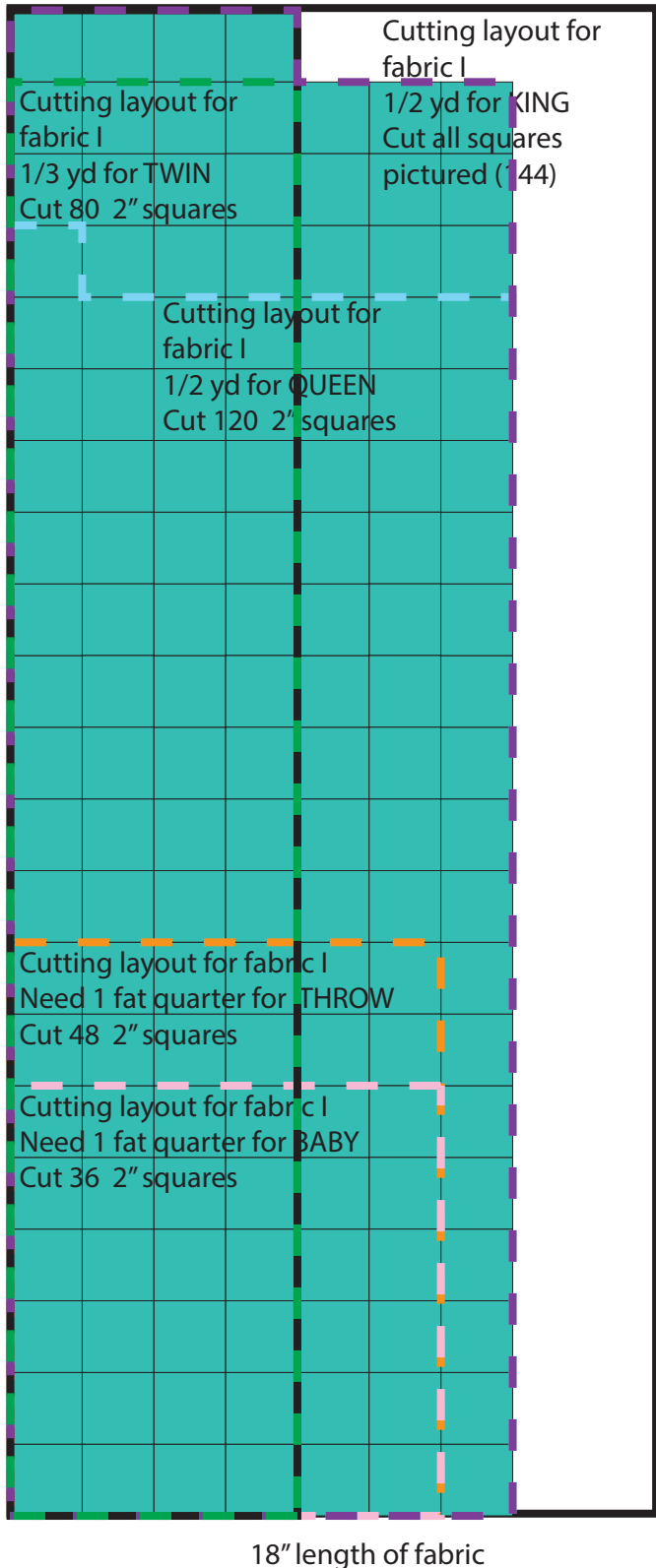
Need 1-3/4 yds for KING size: Cut (11) 5" x WOF strips then piece together border pieces KING

This diagram shows the fabric opened to the full 42" width, not folded in half as it was in the template cutting diagrams.

-  Orange dashed line - THROW
-  Green dashed line - TWIN

-  Purple dashed line - KING

1 FQ for baby, throw
1/2 yd for Twin, Queen, King
